He was one of the best violin players in the city, and he hoped that his daughter would someday become (1), too.

Leopold showed her an instrument called a clavier. It was (2) by many people before the piano became popular. Soon Nannerl could play (3) than many adults.

When Nannerl was eight years old, her brother Wolfgang watched her lessons. He loved his sister very much. He wanted to do everything she did, so he wanted to play the clavier, too. Everyone thought that he was too young for music (4) he was only three years old. However, Leopold was happy when his children were doing things together, so he let him play the clavier.

Suddenly, Wolfgang began to play some of the chords (5) his sister was practicing. Everyone could not believe it, and they didn't know why a little boy like him could play the clavier so well. There was something very strange and special about this young boy.

In 1761, Wolfgang learned to play his first piece of music. Leopold taught him how to play a minuet, and young Wolfgang (6) to play it perfectly. He was only four years old, and it took him just 30 minutes to learn the minuet!

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart was a child genius. He became a great musician and composer.

Satoru is a high school student. In April, he is going to enter a university. It takes three hours by train from his home to the nearest station to his university.

He is going to rent an apartment. Aoba station is the nearest station to his apartment. It is between his home and his university on the same line. From Aoba station, it takes ten minutes by train to get to the nearest station to his university.

After he enters university, he wants to watch cable TV and use the Internet in his apartment. He loves watching TV, and he may need to use the Internet to write reports. Satoru's father wants him to choose a plan with a one-year contract.

Satoru went to a cable TV company and the company showed him four plans. Plan A provides music and sports channels, and 18 other channels for 2,900 yen per month. If he wants to use the Internet, he also has to pay 5,500 yen per month. Plan B provides Japanese movie channels and 39 other channels for 3,800 yen per month, or it costs 9,100 yen for both the TV channels and the Internet. The company also showed him Plan C, and it offers 80 channels. American TV channels are provided only in Plan C. It costs 6,900 yen per month, but if he also uses the Internet, he will pay 10,900 yen per month in total. Plans A, B, and C only need a one-year contract. Plan D offers 60 channels and costs 4,700 yen per month, but it needs a three-year contract. Satoru is thinking about which plan he should choose.

In May, Satoru's family is going to visit his apartment by train. His father already bought the train tickets. They will have a good time with Satoru.

6 生物の移動・渡り (migration) について書かれた次の英文を良く読み, 後の問題に答えなさい。

Some animals always live in one place. A wood mouse, for example, never goes more than one hundred meters from its birthplace. [1]. Often these animals go long distances to travel from one place to the other. We say that these animals migrate.

Most people know that many birds migrate. [2]. In the spring they fly back to their summer homes. For example, swallows fly to Japan in the spring and have their babies. Then they leave Japan in the fall and go to warm places like Taiwan. Many other kinds of animals migrate, too.

Why do animals migrate? There are many reasons. Sometimes they migrate [3]. For example, their summer home is too cold in the winter, or their winter home is too hot in the summer. Sometimes animals migrate when they have their babies. They travel to a place that is safe for the young animals. Sometimes animals migrate to find food.

California gray whales leave the Bering Sea in October and arrive in the warm areas near California and Mexico in December. They have their babies [4] in these warm areas. By March the babies have grown large and are able to travel long distances. These whales then go back to the Bering Sea to live. Whales eat very small plants and animals. Surprisingly, these grow the best in cold water. The Bering Sea is very cold and [5] there. So in the summer, the whales eat and get fat. When fall comes, [6]. Whales migrate because one place does not have everything they need. Migration helps them survive.
