About National Institute of Technology, Akashi College

National Institute of Technology, Akashi College (Akashi Kosen) is located in the western part of Akashi City along the 135th east longitude. It was founded in 1962 as one of the first 12 national technical colleges of Japan.

In 1996, An Advanced Course was established to provide a bachelor's degree.

Currently, we have four departments, which include the Departments of Mechanical Engineering, Electrical and Information Engineering, Civil Engineering, and Architecture.

About the Workshop Program

Japan, a country prone to natural disasters, can be considered an advanced country in terms of disaster prevention technology and disaster prevention education. In particular, the area around Akashi City, where our school is located, was severely damaged by the Great Hanshin Awaji Earthquake in 1995. Since then, our school has established a subject called Disaster Prevention Literacy as a compulsory subject, and has focused on education related to disaster prevention. Disaster prevention technology is a problem that can be solved by use of comprehensive technologies such as mechanical engineering, electrical engineering and construction engineering. This problem is considered to be one of the most suitable topics for students majoring in a wide variety of specialties to work together to take up. In this program, students will learn the basics of engineering design methods and disaster prevention literacy, and learn how to use them through a series of workshops. During the training, participants will visit the Disaster Reduction and Human Renovation Institution and the Memorial Park, where they will also experience the process of applying empathy, which is required in engineering design, to product development. Finally, the students' group will propose a prototype and make a presentation. In addition, this program fosters competency for collaborative work in the international community by conducting collaborative work with participants from multiple countries.
